

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT Wyoming Organizer

Introduction & Background

Western Leaders Network is hiring a part-time, six-month contract organizer, effective October 15, 2018. The primary duty of the Wyoming organizer will be conducting outreach to local and tribal elected officials and educating them on the benefits to local governments and public health of cutting methane waste.

The goals of this position are:

- Build the Western Leaders Network membership base in Wyoming.
- Serve as a spokesperson and recruit local officials to participate in WLN communication activities such as providing statements for news releases and interviews, editorial board outreach, and writing opinion editorials on ozone pollution and methane waste; land five media hits each month.
- Assist Western Leaders Network staff in organizing a forum in Wyoming focused on the need for action on ozone and methane.
- Meet monthly with state administrative staff and participate in stakeholder efforts, as appropriate.

Qualifications:

Successful candidates will demonstrate experience in community organizing, coalition building, advocacy, natural resource issues, and a passion for social change. The ideal candidate will have experience in environmental non-profits, campaign work, excellent writing and communication skills, and, an extensive set of contacts among current and former local elected officials.

Compensation:

Total compensation for this six-month contract position is \$7,500. All expenses, including mileage, airfare, office equipment and supplies, copying and postage are included as part of the \$7,500 contract.
